



FCC PROVIDER ALERT; HEPATITIS A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

In August of 2019, the Florida Department of Health declared a public health emergency resulting from the increase in Hepatitis A cases in Florida.

Facts about the Hepatitis Outbreak:

Critically High Risk impacted counties in Florida are: Brevard, Citrus, Glades, Hernando, Hillsborough, Lake, Liberty, Manatee, Marion, Martin, Okeechobee, Orange, Pasco, Pinellas, Sumter, Taylor, and Volusia.
