ALINIA[®] (nitazoxanide)

LENGTH OF AUTHORIZATION: 3 days

REVIEW CRITERIA:

Diarrhea caused by *Clostridium Difficile*:

• Redirect provider to metronidazole or vancomycin

Diarrhea caused by Giardia lamblia:

• Redirect provider to metronidazole

Diarrhea caused by Cryptosporidium parvum:

- May approve in the immunocompromised patient for:
 - Children 1 to 3 years of age: 100 mg orally twice daily for 3 days;
 - Children 4 to 11 years age: 200 mg twice daily for 3 days;
 - \circ Children \ge 12 years and adults: 500 mg orally twice daily for 3 days

DOSING AND ADMINISTRATION:

- Available as 500 mg tablets and 100 mg/5 mL oral suspension.
